



Public Notice under S.I. no. 209 of 2015 Chemicals Act (Control of Major Accidents Hazards Involving Dangerous Substances)

An Garda Síochána, the Health Service Executive and Clare County Council are each required by the above mentioned regulations to prepare plans to deal with effects off-site and to assist, where relevant, with the emergency response on-site in the event of a major accident at:
